## Write out your story (Sample)

### **BC** 1.) Where were you spiritually before receiving Christ?

*“As I grew up, my mom had a lot of fears and insecurities that were passed on to me. As a result, I did not feel like I could trust anyone, including God.”*

**\*If you became a Christian as a child, you can start with question #2.**

### 2.) What caused you to begin considering God/Christ as the solution to your needs?

*“When I was in college, my roommate invited me to her church where her minister explained that most people try to find security in other people or things. But he said only God could give us the security that we are looking for.”*

### **TC** 3.) What realization did you come to that finally motivated you to receive Christ?

*“I have tried boyfriends, getting good grades, and being involved in school activities. But I realized that the minister was right. They were not giving me the security I needed- only God could do that”*

### 4.) Specifically, how did you receive Christ?

*“I prayed and asked Christ to forgive me for all the wrong things I had done. Then I asked Him to come into my life to lead me and give me that security I had been looking for.”*

### **AC** 5.) How did your life begin to change after you trusted Christ?

*“I did not have the fear and insecurity anymore. I began to feel more confident and at peace because I knew God was in control.”*

**\*If you became a Christian as a child, answer #5 and #6 by contrasting your life to what it might have been like without Christ. This can be determined by reflecting on eras of your life when you weren't close to Him, by considering your weakness and temptation, and/or by observing the lifestyles chosen by old friends or schoolmates who didn't follow Christ.**

### 6.) What other benefits have you experienced since becoming a Christian?

*“I have much healthier relationships now, and also I'm not as afraid of failing as I used to be. Most of all, I now know that I am going to be in heaven for eternity.”*

**Concluding Question:** “Can you relate to any of this?”

**Unifying Theme:** “Looking for security”
